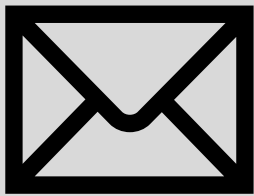

Late Work Policy

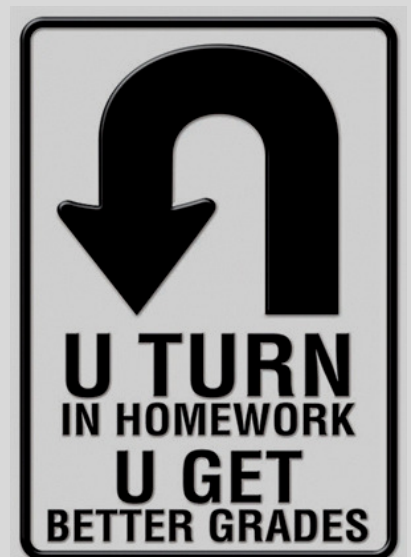
I do accept late work. All late work turned in before the unit test will receive full credit. Late work turned in after the unit test will receive partial credit.
